



THE SALLIE SOUTHALL COTTEN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

This scholarship is awarded based on the candidate's character, scholastic records, evidence of intellectual promise, demonstration of ambition, leadership ability, and need for financial assistance. Applicant must be present for judging and presentation of the scholarship at the time and place designated.

1. Applicant must be a resident of Garner, North Carolina and must be a member of a senior class in an accredited North Carolina high school.
2. Applicant must use the official application form.
3. The scholarship is to be used at a four-year college or university in the state of North Carolina.

THE FOLLOWING MUST BE SUBMITTED

1. Application form
2. Recent photograph.
3. A personal letter as to why student desires to continue his/her education, the student's future plans, and why financial aid is necessary.
4. Letter of recommendation from either the school principal, school guidance counselor, or a school teacher.
5. Letter of recommendation from a business or professional person **OTHER THAN SCHOOL PERSONNEL**.
6. High school transcript with grades through the first semester of senior year, complete SAT and/or ACT scores, class rank with number of students in class, and grade point average weighted and unweighted.
7. Copy of most recent Federal Tax Returns for applicant's parent(s) and applicant. Document any significant changes in family income if necessary.
8. Applicant should be available for an interview with the Scholarship Committee at The Garner Woman's Club in January, 2018.

Applicant will not be considered unless all required items listed above have been received by the deadline.
